



## **Watercolor Supply List**

Artist / Instructor: Bobbin

**Paints:** Can be a set of pan or tubes. You can always add colors to your own personal palette when you decide which are your favorites. Be sure they are artist-grade, **Not** student-grade. If you are picking colors separately, include the following:

Cadmium Red -W	Opera-W
Alizarin Crimson -C	Veridian -W
Cadmium Yellow -W	Sap Green - C
Lemon Yellow-C	Burnt Umber -W
Ultramarine Blue-W	Raw Sienna - W
Pthalo Blue -C	Paynes Gray/ Neutral tint

Black, you will mix to make your own black (don't buy)      White is your paper (don't buy)

My suggestion would be a set Daniel Smith Essential Set

It contains both warm and cool of each color

Hansa Yellow Light      New Gamboge

Quinacridone Rose      Pyrrole Scarlet

Phthalo Blue      French Ultramarine Blue You can always add more colors

## **Brushes:**

It can be synthetic but must be made for watercolor.

Small Round      Medium Round      Larger Round

Can be any number you think you like, 03, 06, 10 just look at them You could buy a synthetic white set or separate ones. Don't go crazy. Bigger you paint the bigger the brushes start smaller, as your paper will be smaller. You only need to start with a small, a medium, a large all - ROUNDS

1" Flat - can use a cheap one from a hardware store or

2.5 Mandalay Hake Brush by Creative Mark (Do NOT buy a \$35. 2.5 " Watercolor Brush.)



**Paper:** There are many types of paper to choose from. Start with the following: Strathmore 140 cold press pad, for practice and exercises.

Arches 100% Cotton, 140 lb, Cold Press - This will give you the best results.

**Miscellaneous:**

2 clear (if possible) water containers

Mr. Clean Magic eraser

Mechanical pencil - cheap one and a kneaded eraser

Paper towels

Old rag, washcloth or cut up old tee shirt

Drafting or blue painters tape (from the hardware store)

Foam board or Artboard with clips for your artwork. If you choose foam board, bullnose clips are really handy to have (4)

Palette, one with a cover which will be good for traveling. I suggest Mijello.
